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Terms & Conditions Of Business

Within these Terms and Conditions the following definitions shall apply:

- 'McQ' - Shall mean McQ Scaffolding Ltd.
- 'Client' - Shall mean the person, partnership, company or organisation named within the McQ Quotation.
- 'Site' - Shall mean the site or property identified within McQ Quotation.
- 'The Project' - Shall mean the work to be carried out by Ideal at the Site within the McQ Quotation.

1. Once scaffolding and other equipment supplied by McQ arrives and is erected at the Site, the cost arising from any damage caused to the equipment by any other party not associated with McQ shall be chargeable to the Client. (This does not apply to reasonable wear and tear).
2. The Client shall be liable for any scaffolding or other equipment supplied by McQ and on hire, which is stolen or unlawfully removed from the Site
3. All scaffolding and other equipment supplied by McQ in relation to the Project is on a hire basis and shall therefore at all times remain the property of McQ
4. Once the scaffolding and/or other equipment has been erected for the Client any adaptations required that are not described in the original McQ Quotation will be subject to further costs. Therefore a quotation will be provided for any adaptation required.
5. McQ will ensure that all structures are sound and constructed for the purpose required by the Client and comply with all applicable Statutory Regulations. The Client is responsible to ensure any modifications or adaptations are only made by McQ. McQ shall not be liable for any damage or injury caused resulting from modifications or adaptations made by any other parties other than McQ.
6. The McQ Quotation will state the hire period included in the costs and any extra hire will be charged on a weekly basis with an amount stated within the McQ quotation.
7. After erection of scaffolding, or any alterations that have been completed by McQ, it will be the responsibility of the client to carry out periodic inspections required by the Building Regulations and to ensure that the scaffolding is used in accordance with, and continues to comply with The Construction (Design & Management) Regulations 2015. McQ can organise weekly scaffold inspections at an additional fee stated within the McQ Quotation
8. It is the responsibility of the Client to ensure all personnel working on the equipment supplied by McQ are adequately trained and skilled to do so. McQ shall not be responsible for any injuries/damage sustained or caused by any personnel other than McQ personnel.
9. McQ will ensure that all structures are sound and constructed for the purpose required by the Client and comply with all applicable Statutory Regulations. However McQ shall not be responsible for any damage caused or injury sustained as a result of unreasonable stresses and loading of scaffolding not specified in the Hand Over Certificate signed by McQ.



10. McQ will ensure that the scaffolding is handed over in a clean and tidy state. Scaffolding is to be handed back at then end of contract is a clean & tidy state. McQ will not be held responsible for any damage caused by debris left on the scaffolding.

11. Payment terms are 30 days from date of invoice unless otherwise agreed with McQ. No retentions or main contactors discounts are acceptable.

12. McQ can in its absolute discretion charge interest at the rate of 8% per annum on the balance of any monies that are not paid within 30 days from the date of invoice.

13. The client grants irrevocable licence to McQ to enter onto the site at any time in order that McQ may collect scaffolding and other equipment supplied for the project.
